Materials include: the annuals called *The Reflector* (1910-14, 1922-25, 1928-30), *The Sage* (1913-18), and the *Whirligig* (1950); a program for the Junior-Senior dinner (1924); the *Greensboro High School Magazine* (1906), which includes Andrew Joyner's story on a William Jennings Bryan's visit to North Carolina that coincided with the death of Dr. Charles Duncan McIver; the Central High School magazine, *Homespun* (1926-27); the Senior High School magazine, *Homespun* (1931); J.L. Mann's handwritten resignation as Superintendent of Guilford County Schools (1916); programs for commencement exercises at Greensboro High School (1910, 1925); an invitation to the reunion of the Greensboro High School Class of '25 (n.d.); the Greensboro High School newspaper, *High Life* (1941-42), and a student handbook (1973-1974).
