Brief Description: This collection consists primarily of the World War I related materials of Capt. Joseph H. Barrier, who was a member of the US Army's 1st Corps Artillery Park. Following the war Barrier became a Vice-President of Jefferson Standard Life Insurance Co. Materials include: pamphlets and manuals associated with World War I, including *General Pershing's Story* (1919) and *Brief History of the First Corps Artillery Park, 1918-1919* (n.d.); a certificate appointing Barrier captain (1917); Barrier's discharge papers (1919); Barrier's notes for motor transport school (1918); souvenir photo books of the Rhine River (ca. 1919); souvenir postcard books illustrating World War I battle sites such as the Somme (ca. 1919); a photo of the troop transport ship U.S.S. *Artemis* (1919?); and a photo of Barrier and other U.S. troops marching in Newport News, Va. (1919?).
